- 3. Read Hebrews 11:1-12:2 as a group. What do you see in these examples that is challenging to you? What do you see in these examples that is encouraging to you?
- 4. The ideas of "things hoped for" and "reward" come up multiple times in Hebrews 11. What is the connection between reward and faith? What reward is promised to those who seek God? How do we know that God will keep His promises?
- 5. What are the "flaming arrows" that most regularly get thrown your way? What are the most common lies you find yourself believing? What truths from God's word could counter those lies?
- 6. Satan's lies can so easily lead us into doubts about God. What doubts do you have about God right now? What led to your doubt? How are you handling your doubt?
- 7. What step of faith do you sense God is calling you to take next? What is keeping you from taking that step? What could help you take it?
