DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick two or three of these to talk about as a group

1. What was most helpful for you from this week's message? Why?
2. How have you typically thought about the idea of finding God's will? Where did this week's teaching challenge you? Where did it align with your previous view of the topic?
3. Just because God has a plan for your life doesn't mean He's going to reveal all the specifics to you. What are some examples of this from the Bible? What does it look like to follow God's leading even when we don't know where we are specifically going?
4. The first step in discerning God's will is to read your Bible. How would you describe your current relationship with God's word? What does your practice of reading the Bible look like? To what degree have you learned to interpret what the Bible means? To what degree have you learned to sensitize your spirit to the Spirit of God?
5. The second step in discerning God's will is to develop a heart for God. What are some passages from scripture that would tell us how to do this? What has it looked like in your life to develop a heart for God?
6. The third step in discerning God's will is to seek godly council. Who in your life can you go to for godly council? When was the last time you sought godly council before making a big decision?

A TRUTH TO TAKE WITH YOU: Your capacity to discern God's will is directly proportional to the closeness of your walk with God.
